Lisbon Treaty: EP now has full 'co-decision' power with the Commission & EU Council



Commission:

Nov 2010: Initial CAP 2020 Proposals

Oct 2011: Publication of Official Legislative proposals 1,500 pages

Report in 4 sections: CMO, Direct payments, Rural Dev, Budget

Sept 2012-2013: Negotiations between EP, Comm & Council on Reform.

Jan 1st 2014- Agreement & Implementation?
Unlikely at present.

Current Position

ICOS:

Lobby Commission to water down and communicate ICOS concerns

Jan 2011: Work with COPA COGECA on Communication-lobby Commission

ICOS lobby of MEPs and Perm Rep of Department

July 2012: ICOS amendments across a range of issues of concern: Market Intervention, Producer Orgs, Active farming etc.

Sept 2012- ICOS Continues Lobbying at inter-institutional level, working with partners.
